Current state

 Massive number of CD/DVD/BD/DLBD images created using debian-cd

- Including *non-free* netinsts

- Including *non-free* firmware bundles
- Live images created using live-build etc.
- Openstack images created using openstack-debian-images
- Running on pettersson

Read my lips! No new CDs!*

- (Approximately) nobody uses them
- Now up to 90 per arch, 927 for stretch d-i alpha 2
- Continuing for older releases only
 - * except netinst

- New name for cdimage.d.o
 - Old name will stay too
- Lots of non-CD images
 - And we're not doing CDs any more!
- Looking for help with a new landing page



Non-free images

- "Unofficial", but should be better advertised
- Discussed at the Firmware talk
- Detailed changes coming for a better user experience
